Dr. Veiga-Lopez's research focuses on understanding the fetal origins of adult reproductive and metabolic disorders. She is interested in how environmental exposures (endocrine disruptors) during prenatal life can induce adaptative mechanisms in the developing organism leading up to pathophysiological consequences during postnatal life. Her lab uses *in vivo* approaches to characterize the pathophysiological outcomes and *in vitro* approaches (cellular and molecular) to understand the mechanisms and pathways by which the pathological outcomes occur.
